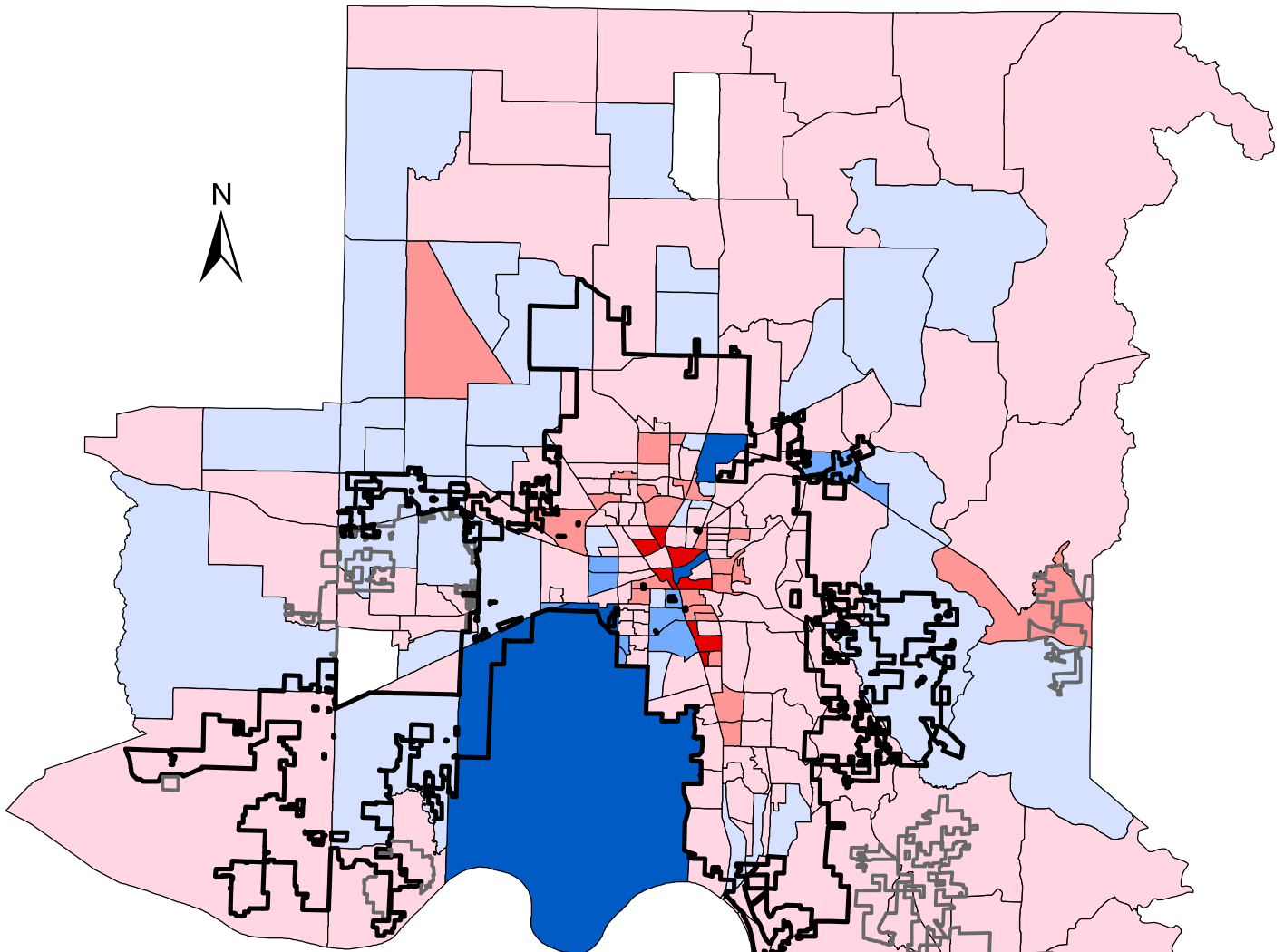
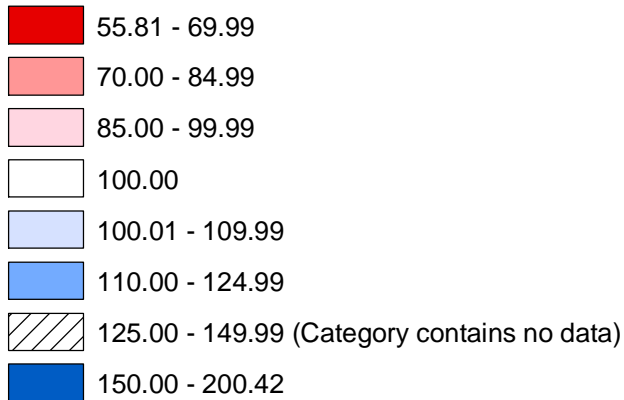


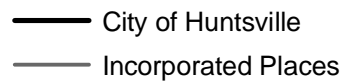
Male To Female Population Ratio by Block Group
