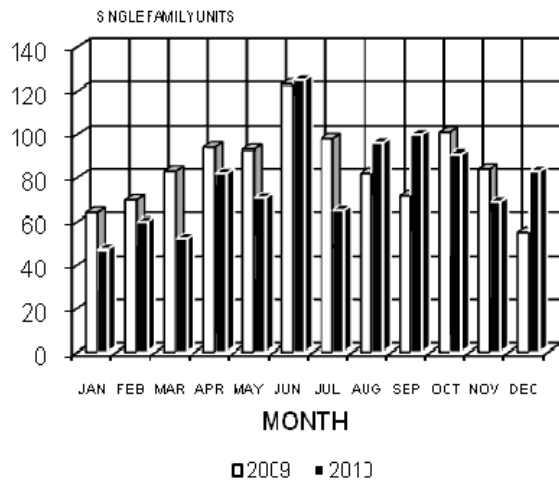

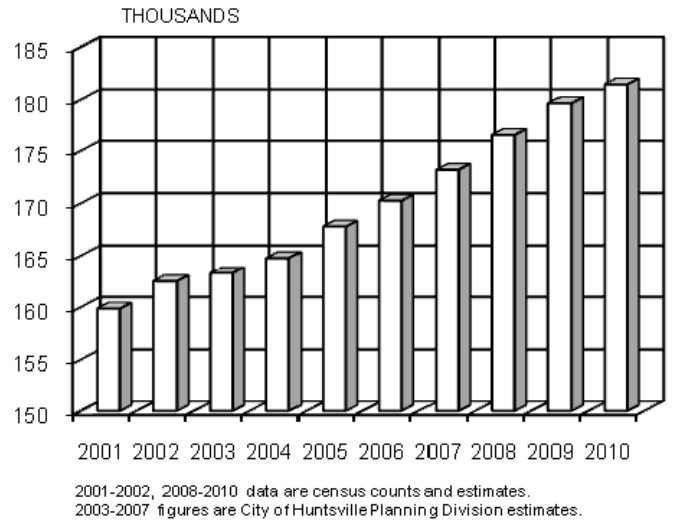

MONTHLY HOUSING PERMITTED CITY OF HUNTSVILLE

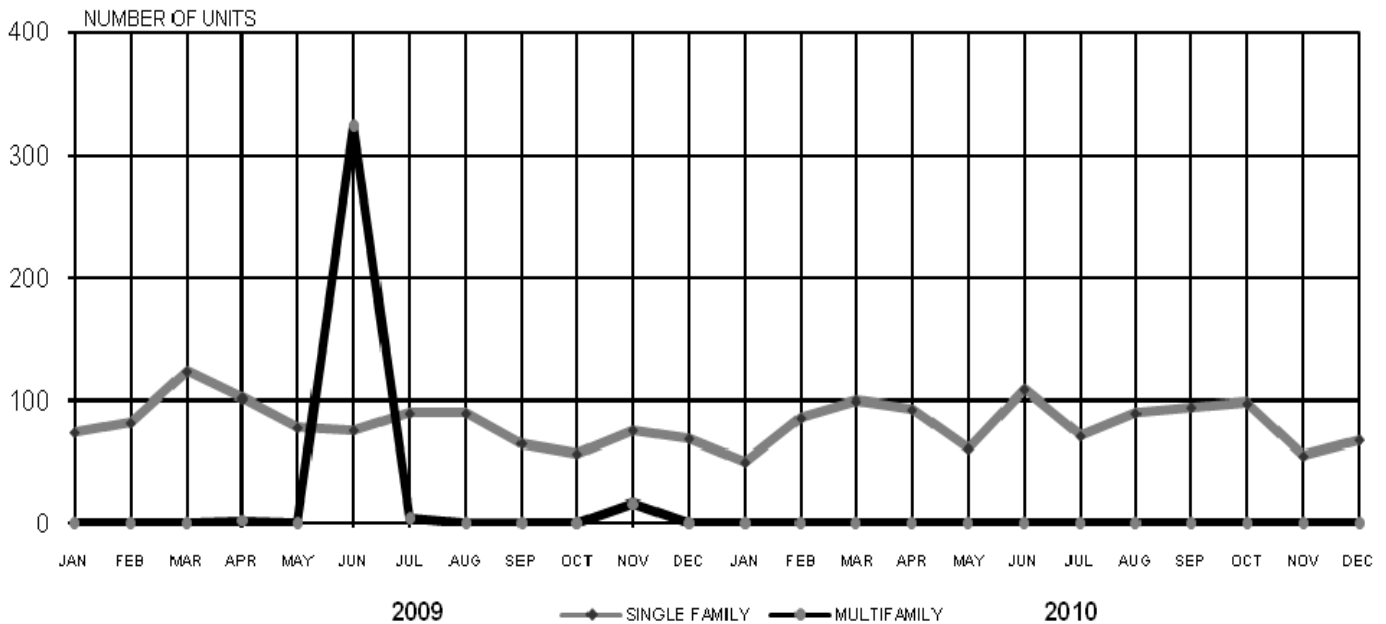

DEVELOPMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- The number of single family lot approvals, single family building permits, and single family certificate of occupancies all decreased this year.
- Multifamily units had the largest change. There were no multifamily subdivision approvals, no multifamily building permits and 52% less multifamily certificate of occupancies issued this year.
- The number of single family homes sold through the Multiple Listing Service had a 6% decrease this year, while the average sales price of the homes sold increased by 6%.
- Population in the City of Huntsville increased by 13.53 between 2000 and 2010.

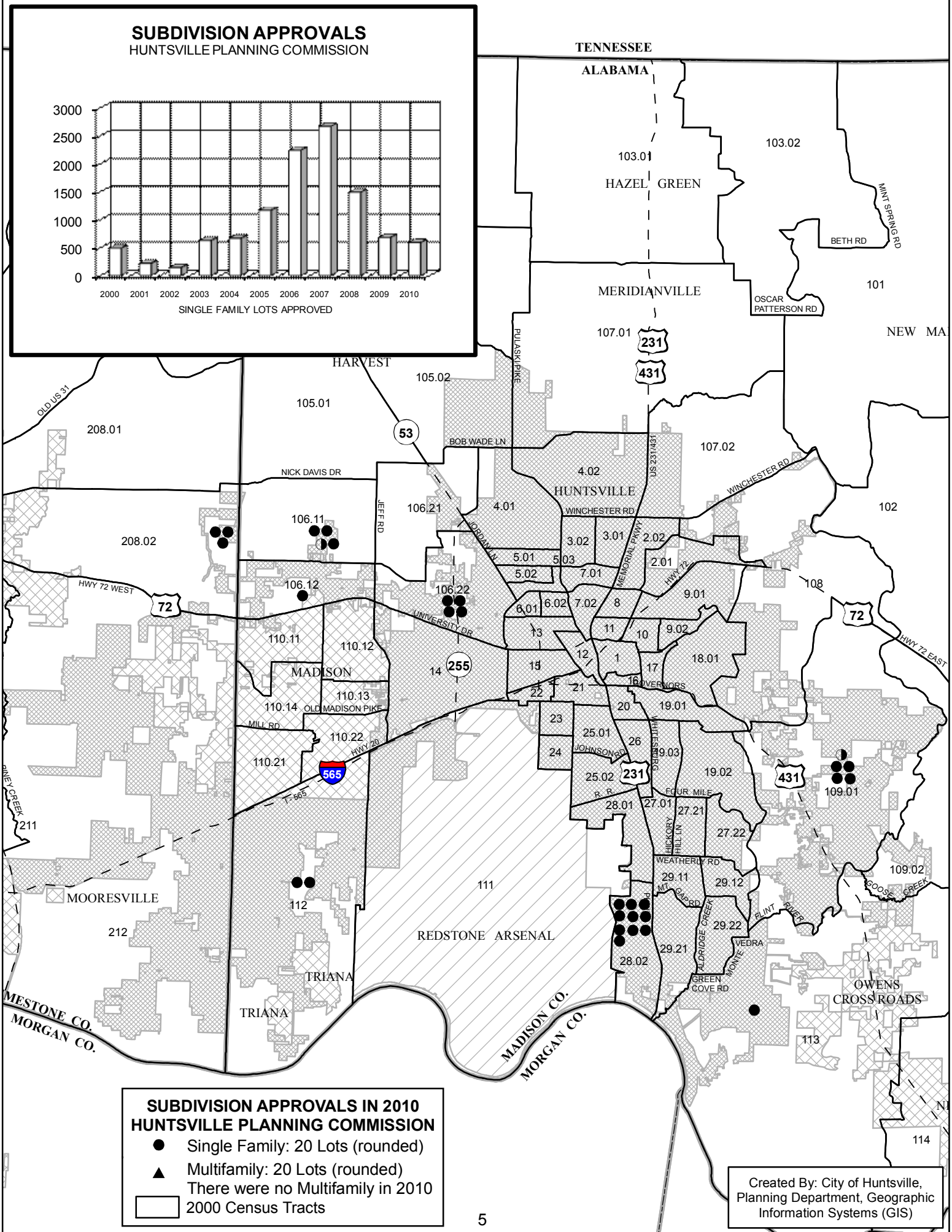
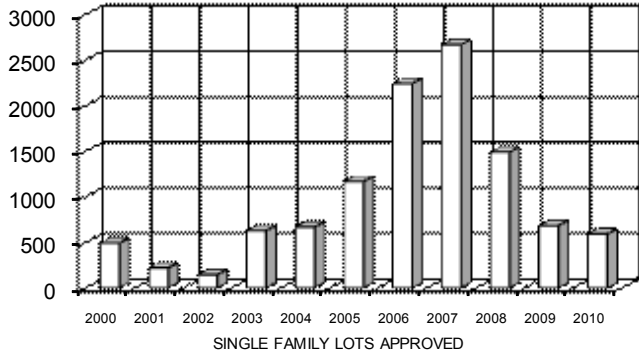

There were 9 minor residential subdivisions, creating 19 additional lots, approved this year. A minor residential subdivision is a division of a tract of land into no more than 3 lots or an unlimited number of lots if each lot is 10 acres or more in size, where each lot fronts on an existing paved public road and does not require the construction of any new infrastructure except sidewalks or water main extensions. Approval by the City of Huntsville Planning Commission is required for all subdivisions within Huntsville. Only final approval for new subdivisions and boundary plat approval for apartments are included in this table.

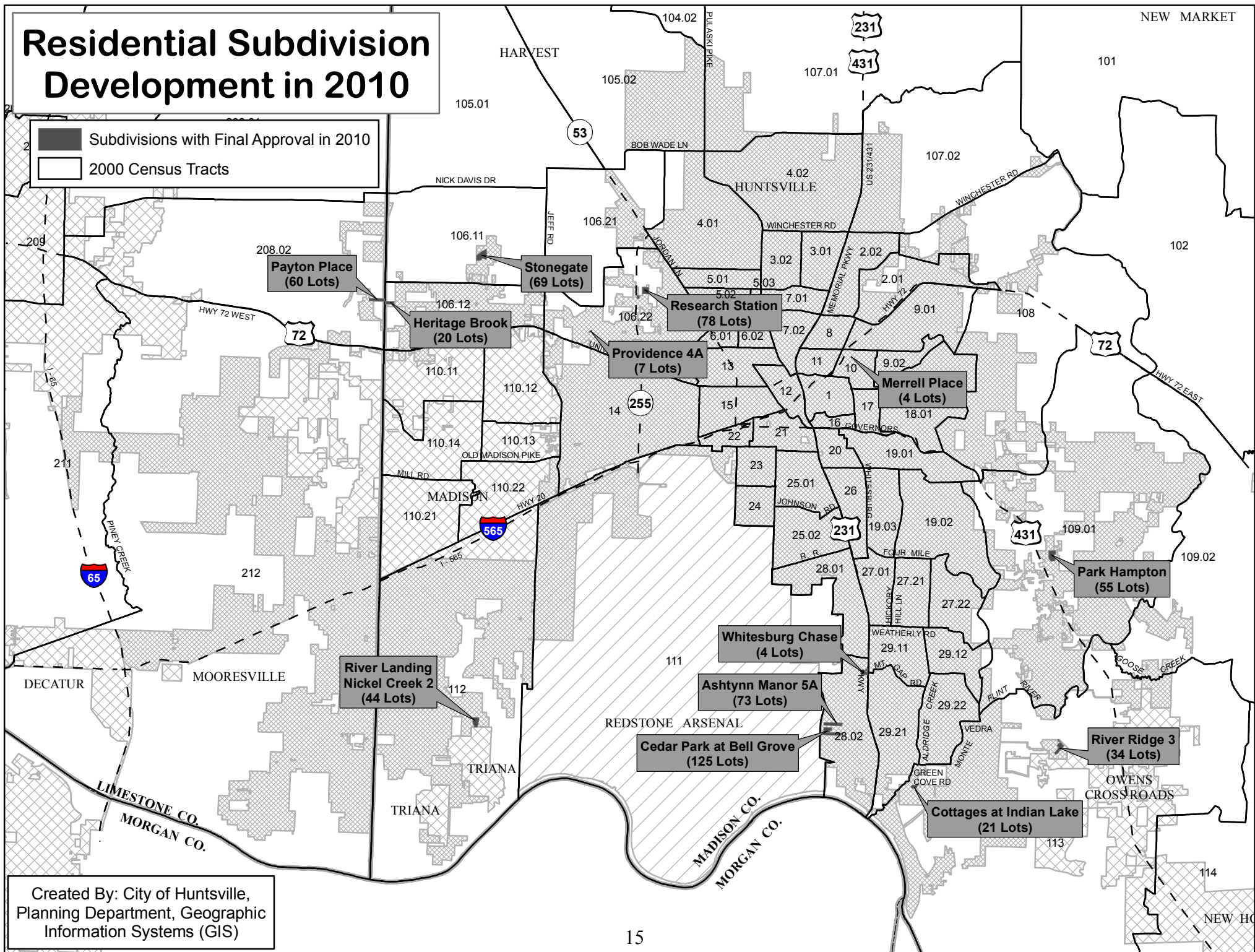

Residential Subdivision Development in 2010

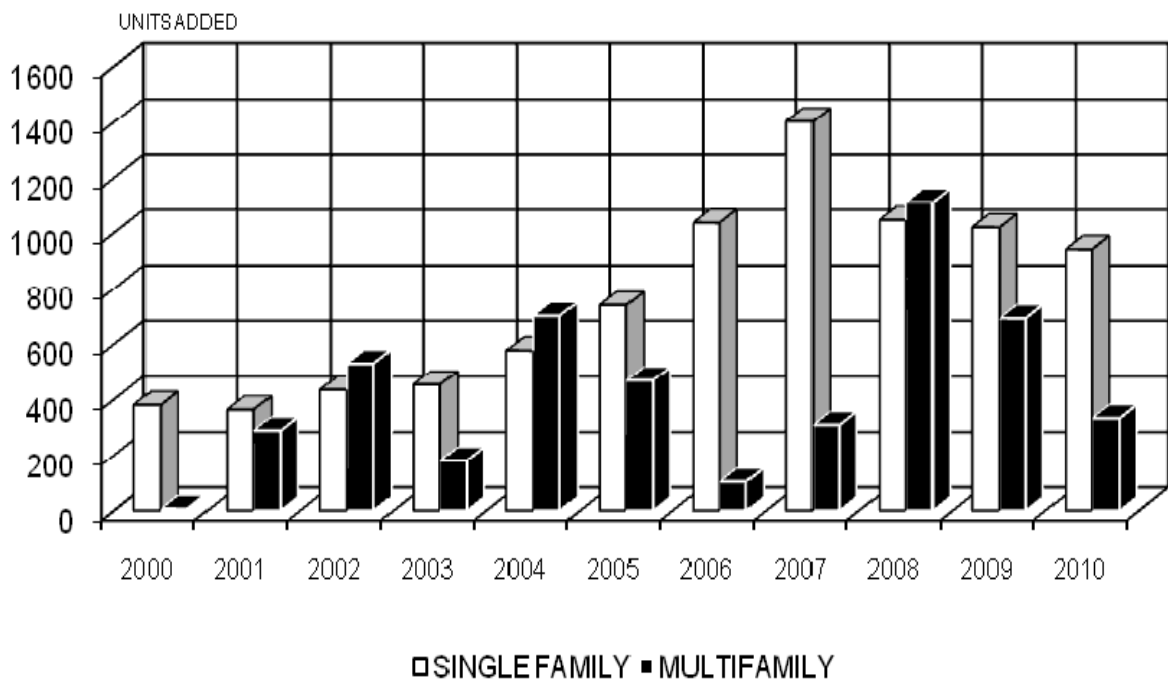
- Subdivisions with Final Approval in 2010
