

Fall Color Hike

This Saturday (Oct 24th) at 1 p.m. is the Fall Color hike at the Hays Nature Preserve. We will be leading it in a different direction this time. We are going to hike up the river to the Old Raiders Bridge, where Civil War Rebels used to cross from the Flint River bottomlands to bushwack the Union troops as they came over Monte Sano. The bridge burned sometime later, but the date of that record has not been found (it was on maps until 1876 though).

This area is where the new Phase II of the Flint River Greenway is coming back across the river. So you will get to learn the fall colors of the species of Bottomland Hardwoods, see a remnant of history and view the beginnings of a new section of Huntsville's Greenway System. Others are certainly welcome to come. It is open to the public. Hope to see you here. We meet in the Parking Lot at 1 p.m.
