Newest Shuttle Bus route serves western portions of the city

Huntsville, Ala. --- Mayor Loretta Spencer and the city's Parking & Public Transit Department launched the city's newest Shuttle Bus route which serves western portions.

The Research Park Route has stops in Cummings Research Park as well as Bridge Street Town Centre, Westside Centre, Wal-mart on University Drive and will link to the soon to open UAH intermodal center.

“This route links to the 11 existing Shuttle Bus routes to provide transportation to the new destinations from all areas of the city currently served by the system,” Mayor Spencer stated. “Commuters, shoppers, students and others will have convenient access to this rapidly developing area of the city.”

The Shuttle Bus is equipped with a wheelchair lift and bike rack for the convenience of riders. The route will cover 8 miles and will run every 30 minutes during its day of operation.

“We will run this route from 5:50 a.m. until 6:15 p.m. Monday through Friday,” Tommy Brown, director of the city's Parking & Public Transit department stated. “From the Shuttle Station located on Church Street riders will be able to arrive in this area in around 25 minutes.”

Cost to ride the Shuttle Bus is \$1. Cost for senior or disabled riders cost is 50 cents.

“We continue to look at ways to enhance the services our shuttle bus system provides,” Mayor Spencer said. “The city's Public Transportation department does an excellent job with an average ridership of 1,500 per day.”
